






#### **GDP Share of Major Economies**





### **Share of World GDP** (%), 1820-2016






#### **Growth in Labor Productivity and Potential Labor Force (%)**






#### **G7 Labor Productivity and Labor Force,** Growth Rates (%)




#### U.S. Leading Manufacturing Index, Growth Rate (%)






#### **EM-DM Long Leading Index Growth Differential (%)**
